



1. Install Desk Mount Assembly



- Determine approximate location for mount, keeping in mind display size, height adjustment and pitch/roll requirements.
- Slip the desk mount assembly over the edge of desk so that clamp fully contacts desk edge.
- Turn the knob to adjust the clamp to edge of desk and secure it tightly.



3-1 Attach Display to Monitor Mounting Assembly








Attach the display to the monitor mounting assembly with the appropriate included screws. Do not over-tighten screws.

3-2 Attach Display to Arm






5-1 Attach Notebook Mounting Assembly





Tighten knob firmly, but do not over-tighten.


5-2 Attach Notebook Holder

5-3 Attach Safety Clips



5-4 Secure Notebook Computer


Place notebook computer in the notebook holder, ensuring it's firmly seated on the front clips. Rotate the side arms inward **1** until the clips rest firmly against the sides of the computer **2**. Tighten the two knobs on the back the notebook holder to secure the computer **3**.





Once the displays are adjusted to their final desired position, tighten the bolts using the included hex keys.

Do not over-tighten bolts.
